
## Getting to C6 using Cidade Universitária metro station



The Cidade Universitária metro station is served by the Yellow Line.

You should exit the station through the Alameda da Universidade and Reitoria route.

Then walk down for app. 150m, cross the road and go down to the whitish buiding with a 5th ITFS banner.

You arrive to C6. Sessions are on the 2nd floor and are signed posted.

## Getting to C6 using Campo Grande metro station



The Campo Grande metro station is served by the Yellow and Green Lines.

You should exit the station through the Faculdade de Ciências route. You can visit Sporting Lisbon stadium on another ocasion :p

Then walk down for app. 250m, cross the road, pass the City Museum and you will see the Faculty of Sciences. Go to your right on a narrower alley/cul-desac street and you will see the greyish C8 building. Go past it and continue to the west.

You will arrive to C6. Sessions are on the 2nd floor and are signed posted.

# Getting to C6 from Entrecampos metro and train station




The Entrecampos station is served by the metro Yellow Line and by the train line.

You should exit the station through the Campo Grande\Av. Forças Armadas route.

Then walk down for app. 800m along the Campo Grande park and go to your left to Alameda da Universidade. Once you see the Fac. Letras and Reitoria, go to your right to a descending street and you will be able to see the whitish buiding with a 5th ITFS banner.

You arrive to C6. Sessions are on the 2nd floor and are signed posted.

The Terreiro do Paço metro station is served by the Blue Line.

If you are leaving from the Universidade área, get the Yellow Line to Marquês and change to the Blue Line (Sta Apolónia direction).

Once you get out of the metro station cross the road to the main square and you will see the Museu da Cervaja to your right and Vini Portugal to your left.

Someone from the Organizing Committee will be there to welcome you to both social gatherings.
